FOOD AND DRINK POLICY ROLLING ACRES & BROWNWOOD

1. **FOOD:**

- a. Food is only allowed in the break rooms, offices, Brownwood Studio, and Brownwood Training Room.
- b. No food is allowed in the areas of the shop where machinery is located, and assembly or repairs takes place. Appropriate signage will be posted.

2. DRINK:

- a. Drink containers of any kind are only allowed in the break rooms, offices, Brownwood Studio, and Brownwood Training Room.
- b. Only drink containers that are specifically "**auto-seal**," "**leakproof**", and "**unbreakable**" varieties are allowed in all other areas of the shop.
- c. Drink containers are expected to be placed with the member's belongings, and in a place that is not near any machinery.
- d. Drink containers must not be placed on any piece of machinery or on adjacent machinery components.
- DEFINITIONS: Auto-seal and leakproof means the container will have a closure that automatically seals the opening when hands are removed from the container. It also means if the container is turned upside down or knocked over, no liquid will escape.
 Unbreakable means the container, when dropped from a waist high distance to the shop floor, will not break or crack.
- f. EXAMPLE: Any auto-seal container may be used. One example to compare what autoseal means is the Contigo Auto-Seal containers, available on Amazon and at many other stores and online outlets. You are not required to use the Contigo brand, however, <u>only</u> <u>a container specified Auto-seal by the manufacture is approved.</u>
- g. **CLOSURES:** Container closures that slide, screw on, latch, clip, flip, or utilize any method of closure that does not auto-seal the container when hands are removed from the container are not allowed in areas other than the break rooms and offices.
- 1. **ENFORCEMENT:** The shop monitors, safety personnel, department heads and leaders, board members, and EOC members shall enforce this policy from day to day. Members refusing to comply, or with repeated infractions, will be subject to disciplinary action.
